This will contained in writings marked A and B was proved at a
Court on 3rd April 1848 before the reverend Judge James Daines Doctor of
Law and surrogate by the order of the Reverend William Daines a
Deputy Clerk one of the executors to receive a commission was granted having a

the survivor of them his executors or administrators as soon as they
shall see after my decease to make sale and absolutely dispose of all
and singular my household furniture, my real books, prints and pic-
tures and implements of household goods and also all and every my real
and Personal Estate and Effects whatsoever and wheresoever and
of whatever nature or kind the same may be either by public auction or private
contract with liberty to buy in the same as they my said executors shall think
proper and also to make execute and perfect all necessary and proper deeds in
writings returns and assurances for the purpose of vesting the same in a
my purchaser or purchasers thereof or in such person or persons and for the
uses and intents and purposes as he or they shall direct or appoint and it
is to be that the receipt or receipts of my said executors or the sur-
vivor of them his executors or administrators shall be good valid and suffi-
cient acquittances and discharges to the purchaser or purchasers thereof for all
or any part of the purchase money which shall be by him or them paid or
for the same or so much thereof as in such receipt or receipts shall be ex-
pressly recited to be received and that no such purchaser or purchasers after
paying the or their said purchase money to my said executors or the
survivor of them his executors or administrators shall be answerable or con-
accountable for the misapplication or nonapplication of the same or any
part thereof and the money to arise therefrom or to be applied as here-
inafter mentioned whereas I am in expectation of a legacy under the
will of John Crow late of Wiltshire deceased or the estate of either
Present and also of a legacy under the will of Robert Ward late of Wiltshire
deceased or the estate of William Lake and whereas I have
Polony of Assurance for one hundred pounds in the Palladium Assurance
Office on the life of myself and my wife and will is that whatever the
amount of the before mentioned legacies may be the money to arise from
my said household furniture real and personal estate as aforesaid and

the said policy of assurance for one thousand pounds first paying there
 out all my just debts funeral and testamentary expence / I direct my said
 executor or the survivor of them his executors or administrators to lay
 out and invest the same in the public funds of Great Britain or in any
 good mortgage security as they may think proper and the interest or
 dividend or annual interest thereon shall be paid towards the
 maintenance of my said daughter and advancement in the world of my said
 daughter namely George Wilhelmina Prescott and Harriet Prescott what the
 said interest dividend or annual interest should not be sufficient for that
 purpose then I direct my said executors or the survivor of them his or
 executors or administrators to take so much of the principal amount as
 sufficient for that purpose and I do hereby declare that each of them or
 my said executors shall be released and discharged only for such amount
 as they respectively shall actually receive by virtue of this my will or
 and either of them shall be answerable or accountable for the other
 of them but each only for his own acts receipts neglects or defaults and it
 is the intent of this my will that the executors or the survivor of them his
 or administrators shall and lawfully receive sundry and several sums
 of all my real and personal estate which he or they may expect or be en-
 titled unto in respect of this effect and lastly I revoke all former wills or
 and declare this only to be my last will and testament in witness where-

 contained and written on one sheet of paper of my hand and seal the

 signed and executed in the said George Prescott the testator in the pre-
